

Flowers! is a book to read for enjoyment, but it also gives you practical tips and suggestions for flowers in meadows, in pots on your balcony and in vases in your home. We get an introduction to the botany of the flowers, and how they work together with nature around them. For readers who want to know more about their cultural history, there are also texts about Shakespeare’s flowers, flower gardens from the Middle Ages, flowers for mourning and celebration, etc.

In all, one hundred or so flowers are presented in words and pictures with information on how to cultivate them, where they grow best, when they come into bloom, aroma and hardiness.
