

Here is the book for frustrated cultivators of berries and fruit, shrubs and flowers, kitchen plants. Now includes a section on trees – lime, maple, hackberry, beech, elm, ash, horse chestnut, oak, willow, poplar, rowan amongst others.

An easy-to-use handbook, packed with facts on how we can identify and protect ourselves against the most common pests. The book gives directions for measures to take – setting up traps, removing animals and plant parts, biological pest control – and also preventative measures. But damage can also be caused by heat, cold, drought, poor oxygen flow ...

Protect your garden contains great close-up photographs of larvae, snails, aphids, mites, insects and all the other creatures that wish to snack on our plants so that we learn how to recognise them.

The book tackles all gardening problems – our starting point can be either the plant or the pest.

Protect your garden is richly illustrated with detailed diagrams and careful descriptions of all kinds of pest control. Parts of the book have been previously published.
