The traditional dress up doll is among the most treasured toys. The charm of doll's clothes lies in the fact that they are miniature versions of real clothes. Tarja Helena, grandmother of five grandchildren, has sewn similar doll's clothes to the ones she used to put on her own dolls - timeless, traditional and beautiful.

The book has altogether 30 charming outfits, which have been grouped according to what they are used for: playing at home and in the yard, daycare, outings, summer heat, daytime naps and visiting just as in real life. The patterns have been proportioned for a baby doll of about 45 cm and include seam allowances. The instructions are clear and easy to understand even for beginners just learning to use a sewing machine.

Ready-made doll clothes are often expensive to buy and the author's idea is to offer parents, godparents and everybody else a chance to enjoy making inexpensive doll clothes themselves.
