The author's important close relationship with nature was the inspiration for the Dream shawls book. The range of designs covers the whole year from wintery warm wool shawls to light, airy lace shawls. Also included are a little bolero and two capes.

Skillful lace patterns and soft natural colour shades are combined in the delicate knits and bring out the structure and patterns of the shawls. Beautiful quality merino, alpaca, silk, linen and wool mix yarns have been used for the designs. The shawls are mainly knitted with 4-6 mm knitting needles.

The lovely photos by Ritva Tuomi convey the book's themes, the essence of the abundant winter snow, the delicateness of spring, the warmth of summer and the plentiful autumn shades.
