In Karin's new book, you will find ideas for about 30 different projects that you can use in your sewing club – for example, embroidered tea towels for the kitchen, necklaces with cloth and wooden balls, pen-cases with printed cloth, pen jars with cross stitch, embroidered Christmas cards, crocheted figures and knitted balls. Karin has invited five handicraft bloggers, each of whom contribute with a personal project.

This book will inspire you to start up your own sewing club, and is divided into five different themes: Dots, Animals, Flowers, Folklore and Christmas. There are detailed patterns and information about which materials you need. Many of the projects can be completed in just one or two evenings, and vary in difficulty from easy to medium.
