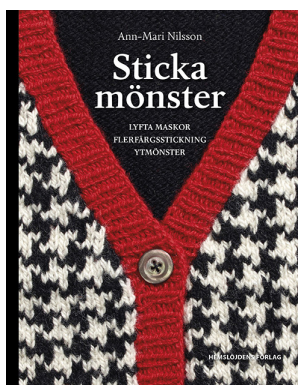


# KNIT PATTERNS
