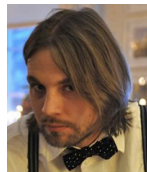
The book contains approximately 20 fun and inspiring craft projects with simple and clear instructions, (all marked according to degree of difficulty) and lots of suggestions for variations.
