Here are garments that warm the neck and head, and many ways of knitting appropriate for scarves - it's important that both sides look good! Whatever you choose to knit, you can make your own combinations of colours and stripes, so that your garment is unique, just like you want it.

The designer Ann-Mari Nilsson has put together 45 patterns for scarves, collars, small triangular shawls, and hoods, all marked according to degree of difficulty. Several alternate colour schemes are offered for each design.
