Among the inspirational sources of the sock patterns in Pirjo Iivonen's first knitting book are Finland's beautiful nature and the enjoyment it provides. The patterns include both textured and colourwork knitting, as well as their combinations. The lyrically harmonious colour world leaves room for artistic knitting patterns transporting us into the Finnish landscape. The romantic names and the texts, full of feeling, tell about the origin of each pattern.

Different techniques have been used innovatively in the sock patterns, which include surprising details, such as the unusual narrowing off of the sock or heel, embroidered or crocheted parts, or even zippers. The new techniques and patterns give a lot to think about, so the instructions are on average quite challenging, but there are also a few easier patterns included.
