The sock patterns by the popular knitting blogger offer a challenge for serious knitters

Tiina Kaarela, the writer of the Puikkomaisteri (*Master of the Knitting Needles*) blog, also a familiar figure from the Ravelry, is famous for her colourful and skill requiring patterns for colourwork knitting.

In her first knitting book she concentrates on woollen socks and takes her readers to new horizons of sock knitting at a go. Susa Junnola's splendid photos supplement the instructions and inspire the reader to grab their knitting needles.

The 22 sock patterns adapt the vernacular motifs of different countries using modern colours and yarns. The end result is splendid socks that are comfortable to wear and catch the eye outside the home.

There is a full-page photo of each pair of socks, detailed written instructions, as well as graphic charts. The patterns in the book have been graded according to their difficulty. The bonus pattern for fingerless mittens give an advanced taste of the author's next book.
